Basye, VA – Water Conservation Request Lifted for Stoney Creek Sanitary District Water Customers.

Over Memorial Day weekend, a public water supply well suffered a mechanical problem, reducing the availability of water supply to the customers of the Stoney Creek Sanitary District in the Basye/Bryce area of Shenandoah County. The reduced supply caused some customers to experience lower water pressure. A call was issued requesting voluntarily water conservation efforts by the community. That call for voluntary water conservation is now lifted.

“I want to thank the many customers who participated in the water conservation effort.” said Patrick Felling, Director of Public Services for Shenandoah County. “Several businesses, like Ashley’s Car Wash, took steps to minimize their use of water during this period. For that we are grateful. Thanks also go to the Town of Mount Jackson, for allowing us to haul water to backfill our supply.”

Mr. Felling continued, “The Stoney Creek Sanitary District crews worked around the clock to fix the problem. The well is back in service, and there is ample water supply. At no time was the water produced by our system compromised.”

Stoney Creek Sanitary District provides water and sewer service in the Basye/Bryce area of Shenandoah County, serving approximately 1500 customers, and supplying up to 250,000 gallons per day of drinking water.
